Funds available:

- Grants of up to \$200 will be awarded by April 1

Who may apply:

- Teachers
- Student teachers
- University instructors
- Summer school or camp instructors
- Other educators

What funds may be used for:

- Purchase materials for waste-related, hands-on student projects
- Field trip expenses as part of a waste-related educational program
- Professional development opportunities (attending a conference, workshops, or seminar dealing with waste issues)

What type of application:

- Submit a brief (2-3 pages) proposal with the following information:
 - (a) Describe primary and secondary audience (size, grade, subject)
 - (b) Intended outcomes; learning objectives
 - (c) For professional development, how will new information be used
 - (d) Project start date and completion date
 - (e) Budget categories and associated costs
 - (f) Proposed final report content (e.g., students' display, photos)
 - (g) Applicant's name, address, and phone number (school and home)

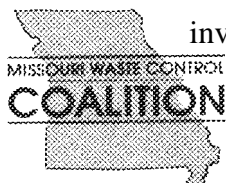
